TEAM SAFE

A school in Manchester has sent out a warning to parents following concerns a teenage dating app is being used by sinister predators.

On further investigation, school bosses found 'the app is being used for inappropriate activities against young people'. A spokesman for NSPCC said: "Any app that allows strangers to send photos to children or vice versa is troubling – particularly where the images being exchanged are of a sexual nature. We advise parents to

talk their children about this and our advice would be to delete the app and block the website.
