Class Updates

Reception

We have all been reading a range of fairy tales, including Goldilocks and the three bears. This inspired us to find out more about real bears, we then completed a research project finding out all about where real bears live. Well done home and school learners!

Class 1

This half term, year 1 have been focusing on our topic 'Frozen Planet'. We have been to the north pole and to the Antarctica and seen both polar bears and penguins! We even caught a penguin in our classroom! The children have made some fantastic moving pictures in DT with sliders, wheel mechanisms and levers. We have loved seeing all your work from home and in class.

Class 2

We have had a wonderful half term in year 2 (in school and at home!) learning all about Africa and safaris. We have read some wonderful books such as Handa's surprise, The Ugly Five and Safari So Good. We've really enjoyed doing some African art, dancing and learning all about the country Kenya.



Each Wednesday afternoon starting from Wednesday 2nd of March will be 'Well-being Wednesday'. During this afternoon each week your teacher will set you some activities to do away from the screen and to help you to relax and unwind.

Class 3

We have had a super half term, home and in class learning all about The Big Friendly Giant by Roald Dahl. In English we have been retelling and sequencing the opening scene of the film and we have been getting better at our SPaG lessons which have made our writing even better! In art/D.T, we have been getting very creative and made lots of fun things linked to the BFG, such as; dream catchers, dream jars and our very own giant!

Class 4

We have been busy learning about the Romans this half term. We have looked at enquiry questions about what Britain was like before the Romans and how historians have been able to learn about the past. We have produced brilliant mosaics and chariots at home and in school.

Class 5

This half term has been all about Space in Class 5. We've had some super work on constellations and space art, from those learning at home and in school. We know all about lunar phases and have kept a moon diary. Also, we have enjoyed sessions with the author of our class book, Cosmic, which has been out of this world!

Class 6
